MINIMUM PANDEMIC WORKPLACE OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS SHOULD BE MET

ADJUSTED OPERATING GUIDELINES TO BE SUBMITTED BY INDUSTRY REPRESENTATIVES TO THE DPHSS PRIOR TO BUSINESS OPENING, BASED ON USDOL & OSHA GUIDANCE ON PREPARING WORKPLACES FOR COVID-19 AS WELL AS INDUSTRY BEST PRACTICES.

LIMITED OCCUPANCY RATE WILL BE ESTABLISHED.

CERTAIN PUBLIC GATHERINGS OR CONGREGATIONS FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES WILL CONTINUE TO BE PROHIBITED.

TO LOWER THE RISK OF SPREAD OF COVID-19, CUSTOMER-FOCUSED AND COMMERCE-RELATED SERVICES AND ACTIVITIES MUST BE ADJUSTED TO INCORPORATE:

- 1. SOCIAL DISTANCING MANDATES
- 2. PHYSICAL WORKSPACE MODIFICATIONS
- 3. TRAINING OF EMPLOYEES ON UPDATED POLICIES AND PROTOCOLS
- 4. OTHER ACTIONS DEEMED NECESSARY BY EACH AGENCY.

CONTINUE PRACTICING GOOD HYGIENE (I.E. WASH YOUR HANDS WITH SOAP AND WATER OR USE HAND SANITIZER, AVOID TOUCHING YOUR FACE, SNEEZE OR COUGH INTO A TISSUE OR INSIDE YOUR ELBOW, DISINFECT FREQUENTLY USED ITEMS AND SURFACES AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE.



MINIMUM PANDEMIC WORKPLACE OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS* CONTINUED

- 1. MANDATE THE WEARING OF FACE MASKS
- 2. DEVELOP AND COMMUNICATE SOCIAL DISTANCING POLICIES
 - SHOULD HELP PROTECT EMPLOYEES (AS WELL AS THOSE WHO FEAR RETURNING TO WORK) AND CUSTOMERS
 - CONSIDER PHYSICAL WORKSPACE MODIFICATIONS
 - CONSIDER DISPLAYING MARKINGS OR SIGNS AS REMINDERS FOR EMPLOYEES AND CUSTOMERS
 - CONSIDER CREATING A SAFETY COMMUNICATION POLICY FOR RETURNING EMPLOYEES AND CUSTOMERS
 - CONSIDER DEDICATED, IN-STORE HOURS FOR VULNERABLE OR AT-RISK INDIVIDUALS
 - CONSIDER WAYS OF REDUCING THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES PRESENT AT THE WORKPLACE (I.E. STAGGERED SHIFTS, ALTERNATING TEAMS, AND/OR CONTINUED TELEWORK).

3. LIMIT IN-PERSON INTERACTIONS AND PHYSICAL CONTACT

- FEWER IN-PERSON MEETINGS
- INSTRUCTING EMPLOYEES NOT TO USE OTHER EMPLOYEES'
 WORKSPACES/EQUIPMENT
- SETTING STAGGERED OR SPACED LUNCH/BREAK SCHEDULES
- WAITING AREA SEATING SHOULD MEET SOCIAL DISTANCING REQUIREMENTS
- 4. TRAIN EMPLOYEES ON SOCIAL DISTANCING POLICIES AND PROTOCOLS
 - MANAGERS/SUPERVISORS MAY NEED ADDITIONAL TRAINING TO UNDERSTAND THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES FOR ENFORCING POLICIES
 - INDIVIDUALS SHOULD BE DESIGNATED AS RESPONSIBLE CONTACTS FOR OVERSEEING AND ENSURING IMPLEMENTATION
 - CONSIDER HOW TO TRACK COMPLIANCE AND CONSISTENTLY DISCIPLINE EMPLOYEES FOR FAILURE TO FOLLOW PROTOCOLS

MINIMUM PANDEMIC WORKPLACE OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS* CONTINUED

- 5. IMPLEMENT REGULAR SCREENING PROTOCOLS FOR EMPLOYEES, CUSTOMERS/CLIENTS, OR OTHER WORKPLACE VISITORS
 - CONSIDER TRAINING PERSONNEL ON HOW TO APPROPRIATELY CONDUCT SCREENING TO INCLUDE TEMPERATURE SCREENS OR OTHER SYMPTOM CHECKS
 - CONSIDER WHETHER THEY WILL REQUIRE PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)
 - SEND ANY EMPLOYEES WHO ARE EXHIBITING FLU-LIKE SYMPTOMS HOME

6. ASSESS SANITARY WORKPLACE CONDITIONS AND POLICIES

- CONSIDER ADDITIONAL CLEANING AND DISINFECTING POLICIES SUCH AS:
 - EXTRA CLEANING AND DISINFECTING OF EMPLOYEE COMMON USE AREAS AND ITEMS HANDLED BY CUSTOMERS
 - DISINFECTING SEATS AND OTHER CONTACT SURFACES BETWEEN USE BY CUSTOMERS
 - MAKING CLEANING SUPPLIES/HAND SANITIZER AVAILABLE TO EMPLOYEES AND CUSTOMERS
 - PROVIDING AND REQUIRING HAND WASHING AND/OR GEL HAND SANITIZERS TO EMPLOYEES AND CUSTOMERS PRIOR TO ENTERING THE WORKPLACE
- ANALYZE INFRASTRUCTURE (I.E. AIR CONDITIONING, AIRFLOW SYSTEM, ETC.) FOR MAXIMUM SANITARY CONDITIONS
- DISINFECT AND CLEAN BATHROOMS ON A PERIODIC BASIS DURING DAY

HOW IS PCOR 2 DECLARED?

- EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-11 EXTENDED THE PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY AND ESTABLISHED THE PANDEMIC CONDITIONS OF READINESS SYSTEM
 - EXTENDED ALL THE RESTRICTIONS
- MEDICAL DATA AND PUBLIC HEALTH PREPAREDNESS TRIGGERS TO INFORM A DECISION BY THE GOVERNOR ARE DETERMINED TO HAVE BEEN MET
- AN EXECUTIVE ORDER MUST BE PROMULGATED BY THE GOVERNOR OF GUAM WHICH WILL SET OUT THE DETAILS OF SUCH DECLARATION TO GRADUALLY LIFT RESTRICTIONS IN LINE WITH THE PCOR SYSTEM
 - OCCUPANCY RATE FOR RE-OPENING IN PCOR 2 WILL BE ESTABLISHED
 - DPHSS GUIDANCE MEMO RELATED TO THE AUTHORIZATION FOR CERTAIN BUSINESS/NGO ACTIVITIES TO BE EFFECTIVE
- ☐ FLEXIBILITY IN THE DETERMINATION OF AUTHORIZED BUSINESS/NGO ACTIVITIES DURING PCOR 2.

WHEN IS PCOR 2 EXPECTED TO BE ANNOUNCED/DECLARED?

- ANNOUNCEMENT FOR THE POTENTIAL TO MOVE TO PCOR 2 WAS DONE ON MAY 6, 2020 BY GOVERNOR LEON GUERRERO
 - THIS WAS DEPENDENT ON CONTINUED MONITORING OF MEDICAL DATA AND PUBLIC HEALTH PREPAREDNESS STANDARDS
- DECLARATION (EFFECTIVE DATE) WAS MENTIONED TO BE ON MONDAY, MAY 11, 2020 SUBJECT TO THE AFOREMENTIONED MEDICAL DATA AND PUBLIC HEALTH PREPAREDNESS CRITERIA
