## Outage Needed to Support Transmission Line Repairs

(Fadian, Mangilao) - Guam Power Authority advises the public that in order to allow for our Snohomish PUD Washington crew to make repairs on the 115kV Transmission line, certain distribution feeder line needs to be secured. **This line which feeds power to customers in the villages of Sinajana, Agana Heights and parts of Ordot/Chalan Pago may be interrupted, the outage could be from 11 a.m. to 8 p.m. today.**

The transmission lines vital to the stabilization of the IWPS sustained widespread damage from Typhoon Mawar. As island power is restored to the community, the repairs to the transmission lines become increasingly critical. The repair of the 115 kV line from Harmon substation to Hagatna was completed yesterday, with the last leg of repairs being between Hagatna and Piti. The repair to the express line is expected within a week.

*A schedule below represents the general areas affected and is subject to change based on how quickly the repairs are made and lines restored.*

### **Affected areas include:**

#### HAGATNA

- Hagatna-Mongmong to East O'Brien left side to Agana Library, Route 4 Agana Shopping Center, McDonalds and surrounding areas

#### AGANA HEIGHTS

- Chalan Palasyo, Government House, Civil Defense, Agana Heights. Agana Heights Elem. School, BBM Catholic School, CL Taitano Elem. School and surrounding areas.

#### SINAJANA

- Sinajana village Underground, GHURA Housing and Sinajana Mobil  
Along Rte 4 to Mobil, including St. Jude Thaddeus Church and surrounding areas.

#### ORDOT/CHALAN PAGO (OCP)

- From Afame on Rt 4 to Shell gas station, Dero road and surrounding areas
